# 2020 - What a year!

In spite of a global pandemic, God was still on the move through GAIN – encouraging families in ministry to continue in the sharing of the Gospel of Jesus Christ. We hosted a June GAIN retreat in Ocracoke and an October GAIN retreat in Corolla (a new location) and invited 10 *new* families in ministry to join the GAIN family. All that God did during these two weeks would have been enough to say that 2020 was a great year, but He did more! Read on...

In the fall of 2019, our board decided to consider ways to serve past GAIN participants by offering "reunion" events. So 2020 included lots of connecting with old friends and establishing new relationships as well. We joined together for two Nights of Worship (NOW) in Clinton, NC with 16 different GAIN families in February and in November. We added Paul Tripp's Parenting Conference to our normal offering of the Weekend to Remember marriage getaway, and five GAIN families benefited from these marriage and parenting enrichment opportunities. Leading up to Easter, we reached out to GAIN families to see how we could support them in prayer. 40 GAIN families responded, and the prayer team covered them in prayer for the entire week. We also drew winners daily to receive a gift that they could enjoy as a family (a gift card, a puzzle, or a game) during the nationwide quarantine. In October, a donor sponsored a GAIN foursome for a Golf Tournament benefiting Tim's Gift.

**Family Day at Hubb's Farm** We wrapped up a year of GAIN events at the beginning of November at Hubb's Farm, where five families in ministry joined us for a day of fun and enjoying one another. We saw pastors who knew of each other (but had never had the opportunity to meet) make a real connection.

### **Respite in Corolla**

In August, we provided three different families in ministry with a week of respite in Corolla, NC. We also learned of a missionary family and their team who were returning to the states for a home assignment. This mission team had to quarantine for 14 days after arriving in the U.S. In November, we were able to give them an offering to help offset some of these unexpected costs.



# Sharing the Gospel through Hospitality:

Aubrey's Story

Corolla Chapel started sowing the seeds of the Gospel in Aubrey's heart four years ago when he attended their international dinners while he was in Corolla on a work exchange visa. He noticed something different. Then he stayed with the Emblers for several extended stays in Clinton and began to meet more of the Body of Christ. Since Aubrey is living in Clinton right now, we asked if he'd like to serve on GAIN 25 in Corolla, and he agreed. We hoped he would experience more of the love of Christ and that more seeds would be sown in his heart - that ONE DAY he might follow Christ if we all just continued to be the hands and feet of Jesus. What he saw was more hearts pouring out the love of Jesus again in service to strangers...with no expectation of something in return. He described the house where the participants were staying as "warm" and that he could feel a burning in his heart when he was with us all. (The love of Jesus! He could feel it!) Several people sat down throughout the week and answered his questions and concerns and others just welcomed him as a new friend. He saw passionate worship. On Saturday morning, someone sat down with Aubrey to ask him pointed questions about his relationship with God and to share the Gospel with him. Aubrey prayed to follow Jesus and was baptized after the Sunday service at Corolla Chapel. And now, my dear brothers and sisters, we all have a new brother in Christ!!!
